We have had to make a couple of changes to the diary dates to fit in with other things that are going on in the borough, so please keep checking the school website as this is up-to-date.



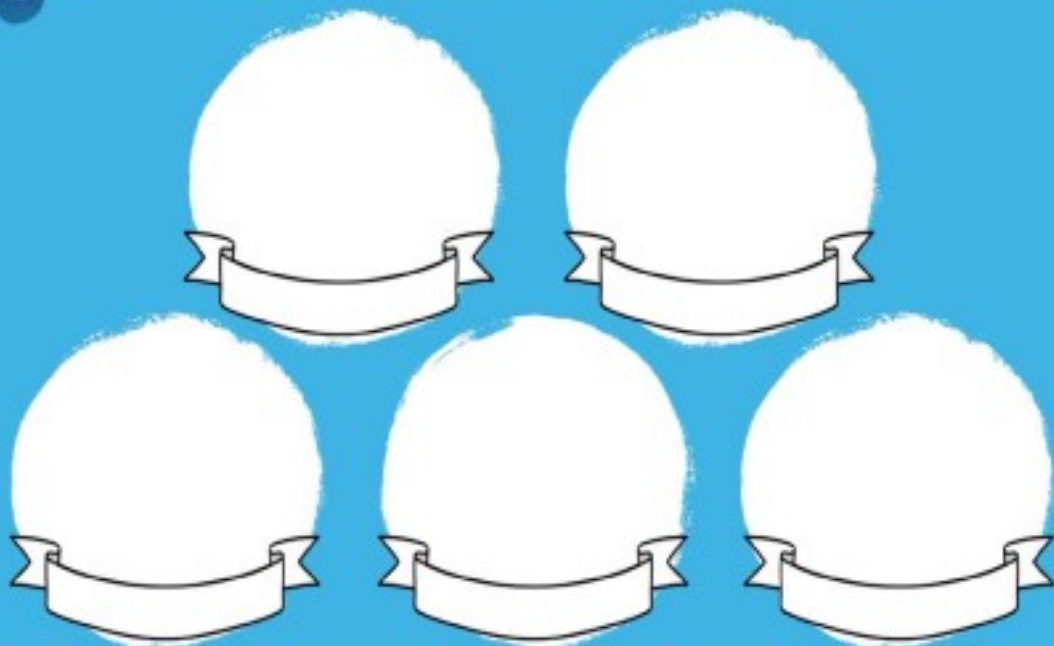
